There are eight different art camps including a new camp *Fun with Art!* for rising prekindergarten through first grade girls who love to explore and experiment with art materials. Performing arts will offer drama and dance camps. The always popular cooking camps are being expanded this year to include baking and cake decorating as well as a *5 Days, 5 Different Experiences* cooking camp with a caterer and special events planner.

Girls looking for some pure fun can sign up for *U Go Girl!* camp which features a pajama party, dress up games and a spa day or the *Disney Extravaganza* dance camp. Others who are interested in some of the wonder and mystery of science will enjoy *Be a Mythbuster* camp. And still others who love games can learn a little bit about the history of the world through board games and outdoor games with one of SCA's history teachers.

Girls wanting to hone athletic skills this summer can choose from camps in tennis, lacrosse, volleyball, basketball, soccer, conditioning, cheerleading and dance.

Academic camps continue to be popular and will expand this summer, too. Study skills and organization camp will again be offered this year after its popular premier last summer. *Science Olympics* promises to be a great camp for girls interested in engineering and building things as well as constellations. *Fun with Geometry* and *Algebra Help* will give girls a chance to work on math skills in a fun atmosphere with SCA teachers and students.
